Cummings grew up playing tennis. "Everybody in town plays," he said. He knows that every Roseville team will be well today for the Raiders past their first-round in the state tournament. Edina's Hornets, who are sending state champ BJ Jefferson. "I think the tournament come down to Edina or Roseville," Cummings said.
