Notes: This meet serves two purposes. The first two Duluth finishers advance to the State Meet while the other District 27 top finishers advance to Region 7. Since Superior athletes were not eligible to advance, Superior was barred from the Meet.

The meet managers chose to vacate records when teams no longer participate in the meet.

Until 1935 a hurdle disqualification occurred if the athlete knocked over three or more hurdles.
